This project developed 50km of signed cycle/walking route linking the Inis Eoghain Peninsula (Donegal) to Derry City, incorporating both on and off road sections. The route runs from Derry City, passing through Carrigans, Churchtown, Newtowncunningham and Burnfoot. Route information includes detailed directional signage, information panels and printed literature.

The project was led by Derry City Council, in partnership with the International Fund for Ireland, Road Service, DoE Environment and Heritage Service, Donegal Council, Sustrans and the North West Development Office.

Through its implementation, the project promoters aimed to address economic and social development, and the creation and support of an environmentally and economically sustainable, enterprise culture for this region.
